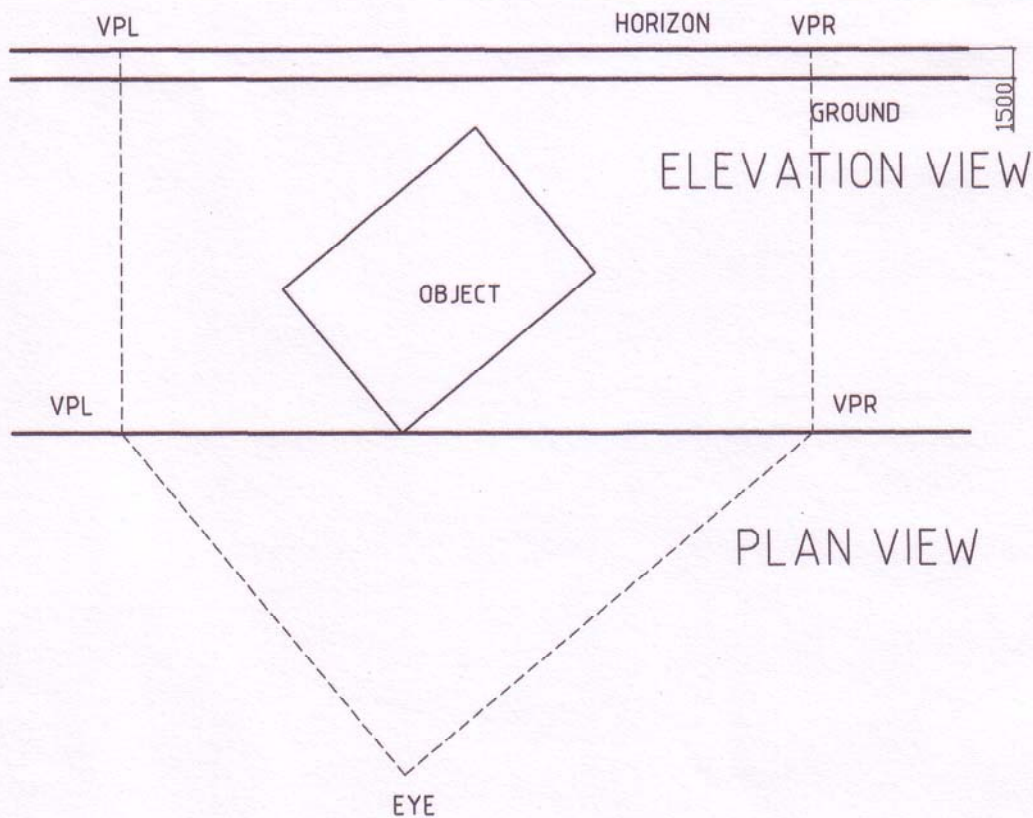


8 To locate the ACTUAL VANISHING POINTS on the horizon, project vertically from the Vanishing Point locations on the plan view to meet the horizon line. Note these as VPR (vanishing point right) and VPL.



9 As noted above, the ONLY place where you can draw scaled measurements in perspective is where the object "touches" the picture plane.

If the picture plane does not touch the object, we pretend to EXTEND THE OBJECT IN PLAN VIEW until it does. Use broken lines for this as they are not real lines only pretend.

Where an extended line meets the picture plane, note this as TH (true height) on plan.

Project vertically from this TH point through the ground line as this is where we will mark off the heights of the object and its detail.
