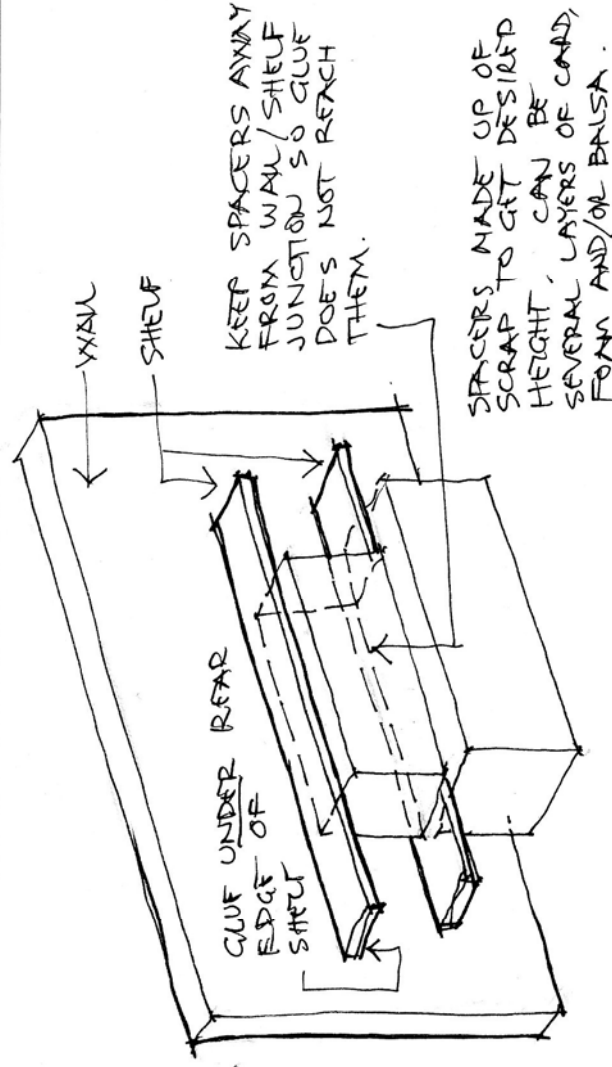


4 WALL SHELVES (suitable for 1:100 and 1:50 scale models only)

MATERIALS: white 1mm cardboard and scrap foamcore (or anything handy) for spacers.

Edge-gluing of cardboard is really tricky so you must be so careful when applying the glue not to let it spread to the top face of the shelf (underneath is OK).

It may be advisable to make a back and sides out of card so the shelf unit is a self-contained box easy to assemble, locate and fix in position. If this does not give your model the "floating shelves" character you wanted, then glue the edge of the shelf to the wall using the spacers to keep the shelf level and straight and maintain the same spacing between shelves for that disciplined "sharp" look. Be very careful not to let the shelf glue and spacers touch otherwise the spaces become an unwanted part of your finished model.



Again, the purpose of a "white" model is to show the general character, solids and voids to describe your design.....detail info is not required and usually, other materials like balsa etc may detract from this spatial modelling even though they may look great. You are applying material and texture/colour to a part of your model
